## INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE BAPTISM CELEBRATION

## When to arrive:

If you are being baptized during the first service, please arrive by 8:40 AM.

If you are being baptized during the second service, please arrive by 10:25 AM.

## What to bring:

Bring water shoes, a towel, clean wash cloth or handkerchief and a dry change of clothes. Prior to the baptism please be changed into the clothes you will be baptized in. One of our staff will be available when you arrive before service to show you where to put your dry clothes. There will be a men's and women's restroom available just outside the auditorium doors to change your clothes in after you get baptized.

You will be escorted into and out of the water. You can either watch the remaining baptisms or change right away in the designated restrooms. Change quickly and return to the auditorium or lobby area so that you can be a part of the remaining celebration.

## What to wear:

- Males: A dark colored t-shirt and dark bathing trunks/shorts, and water shoes.
- Females: A dark colored t-shirt over appropriate under garment and dark colored shorts/pants, and water shoes.

As you come out of the water a helper will be there to offer you a hand and will hand you your towel (don't forget to bring one). Below is an illustration of what it will look like to be baptized in the tank.

If you have a special person in your life baptizing you, please have them follow all of the instructions above as well. Please let us know who you desire to baptize you BEFORE Sunday so we can give them instructions.
